**CALIFORNIA 2010 STRATEGIC FIRE PLAN REVIEW ANNOUNCEMENT**

Announcement Date: February 11, 2010

The Board is required to develop a plan to provide protection for State Responsibility Areas under Public Resources Code § 4130. We are pleased to present this draft of the 2010 Strategic Fire Plan for California for your review and comment.

Please carefully read the background starting on page 5 to help set the context for this plan. You should then review the Vision to see if it captures the appropriate direction for California. Then review the Goals and Objectives, to see if you believe they will help to achieve that vision over a ten-year period.

Each of the Goals and Objectives are meant to build upon one another...starting with planning and collaboration and ending with recovery after a fire occurs.

You will note that this Plan is strikingly different from any Fire Plan ever completed in the past. This has been a joint effort between the State Board of Forestry and Fire Protection and the Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL FIRE). It is meant to be an adaptable plan, with periodic updates to adjust for changing conditions and priorities.

The basis for this Plan started with a dedicated and talented group of volunteers from across the state that served on the Fire Plan Steering Committee. We could not have achieved the Plan without their expert insight and dedication.
